

## TRANSPORTATION

### AIR

Indiana International Airport is the 5th in airports by landed weight of all-cargo operations and home to the 2nd largest FedEx hub in the world.

### RAIL

1<sup>ST</sup> in the U.S. for rail tons of primary metal products originated and 4<sup>TH</sup> in the U.S. for total freight railroads with 41.

### ROAD

### WATER

With 3 international ports and 400 miles of navigable waterways, Indiana is home to the only statewide port system providing international connections for America's Heartland via the Great Lakes and Ohio-Mississippi river system.

### INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT

By the end of calendar year 2015, over \$11 billion will be invested in new infrastructure and preservation.
